



1. CATHEDRAL SQUARE (Arsenalo g. 1)

Open daily 7:00-19:00, www.katedra.lt.

The Cathedral of St. Stanislav and St. Vladislav is the most important place of worship for the country's Catholics. The chapel of St. Casimir is one of the most masterful early Baroque monuments in Vilnius.

Next to the Cathedral you will see the Palace of the Grand Dukes of Lithuania (opening for visitors 2013-2014),

2. GEDIMINAS TOWER (Arsenalo g. 5)

Open daily 10:00-19:00. Ticket 5 LTL, www.lnm.lt The exposition of the Gediminas Tower Museum displays reconstruction models of Vilnius castles from the 14th-17th centuries, iconographic parts of old Vilnius. An observation deck on the top of the tower is the best place to see a magnificent panorama of

the city. Don't forget to take a camera with you!

A funicular runs to the top of the hill from the courtyard at Arsenalo q., 3 LTL for a round-trip ticket.



3. ENSEMBLE OF ST. ANNE AND BERNARDINE CHURCH (Maironio g. 8, 10)

The church of St. Anne is a masterpiece of the late Gothic period. St. Anne's Church, which has survived to the present day without changing for over 500 years, has become a symbol of Vilnius. Next to the church stands Bernardine church. www.bernardinuansamblis.lt.

4. UŽUPIS REPUBLIC (Užupis)

Užupis is a "republic" of artists. It has its own anthem, constitution, president, bishop, two churches, one of the oldest graveyards in Vilnius, seven bridges, and a guardian – the bronze angel of Užupis.

5. AMBER GALLERIES (Šv. Mykolo g. 8, 12)

The Amber Museum-Gallery exhibition hall (Šv. Mykolo g. 8) is located in the basement of a 15th century building. Visit the exhibition of modern art, where imaginative artists will drastically change your stereotyped attitude towards amber. Free entrance. Open daily 10:00-19:00.

At the Art Centre of Baltic Amber (Šv. Mykolo

g. 12) one can enjoy expositions of works made by Lithuanian and foreign artists. Open daily 9:00-18:00. Free entrance. www.ambergallery.lt



6. GEDIMINAS AVENUE (Gedimino pr.)

Gediminas avenue connects the historical city centre, Cathedral Square, with the Seimas Palace. On your way to Cathedral Square, visit the monument to Vincas Kudirka, author of the Lithuanian anthem (V. Kudirkos Square) and Money Museum of the Bank of Lithuania, Totorių g. 2/8, free entrance, open Tue-Fri 10:00-19:00, sat 11:00-18:00,





7. MUSEUM OF GENOCIDE VICTIMS (KGB MUSEUM) (Aukų g. 2A)

Open Wed-Sat 10:00-18:00, Sun 10:00-17:00.

Ticket 6 LTL, www.genocid.lt

For Lithuanians, this museum's building is a symbol of the 50-year-long Soviet occupation. Set up in the former KGB headquarters, the museum is the only one of its kind in the former Soviet republics. The museum's

objective is to collect, keep and present historical documents about different forms of physical and spiritual genocide against the Lithuanian people, and the ways and extent of the resistance against the Soviet regime
